Restoration is the act or process of returning something back to its original state or condition. It relates to something that used to be a certain way and being returned to its original state. It is the act of renewal, revival, re-instating, or re-establishment. Why do we need to pray for restoration? It is simply because the devil has corrupted the things that GOD created perfectly and has caused many believers to derail in destiny and calling. Nahum 2: 2, says, **"For the Lord will restore the excellence of Jacob Like the excellence of Israel, For the emptiers have emptied them out And ruined their vine branches."** Our best-laid plans are bound to fail, life often knocks man's best effort out of whack, not for lack of effort or foresight. The Bible teaches that, **"A man's heart plans his way, But the Lord directs his steps."** Proverbs 16: 9. A person can plan out every aspect of their life, their future events, but GOD is The Ultimate Decider. GOD is The One Who decides what will happen. None of our best intent or plans can override the will of GOD (Psalms 33: 10; Job 42: 2). What does that say about planning? We still have to plan; our plans need to align with the will and the purpose of GOD. His plan leads us in a good path, and to a successful end.

The Bible says, **"When the hedge is broken, the serpents will bite"** Ecclesiastes 10: 8. Humanity are often not in control of the affairs of their life. The Bible qualifies him as a man who was **"blameless and upright, and one who feared God and [a]shunned evil."** Job 1: 1

Then the enemy (Satan) came knocking. While Satan appeared before GOD, he (Satan) challenged GOD, saying, **"Have You not [i]made a hedge around him, around his household, and around all that he has on every side? Satan telling GOD to take away Job's blessings, take all that he has and see if he will not deny You, even to Your face. GOD was sure of Job's righteousness towards Him, that in any situation, he will remain faithful, and unwavering in his faith towards GOD. In the turn of event, Satan was granted permission to test Job's fear of GOD. Satan carried out this testing by taking job's livelihood, such as his material possessions, family, and of course his wellbeing, that is, his health (Job 1: 12; 2: 6). All in his attempt to make Job to curse GOD.

The goal of the enemy is always to rob us of our divine blessings. According to John 10: 10 which says, **"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy."** The good news to us is that whatever was lost, GOD is able to bring back and better than its original state. Jesus says, **"I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."** GOD is able to restore all that we've lost. JESUS came to the world to stop the tyranny that the enemy seeks to launch on our lives. In CHRIST, we have our victory. JESUS says, **"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you [a]will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."** John 16: 33

Therefore, divine restoration is not getting exactly what has been lost, that would be recovery, as in the case of David (I Samuel 30: 8). Divine restoration is a process of receiving far more that we have lost. It's a process because we've to wait on GOD to restore us to our promised state.

Whenever you desire to possess your possession, no matter what height from which you may have fallen, our GOD is ready to restore you when you call unto Him. Job lost all, but, in the end, everything was restored to him, even in multiple fold (Job 42: 10). GOD says, **"Call unto me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."** Psalms 50: 15 **"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."** Matthew 11: 28 Let's go to The Lord in prayer. Do not be distracted or concern yourself about who might be listening to you. Their restoration is not the same as yours. They do not know what you have lost or are in the brink of losing. Restoration is not a thing to be taken lightly. Pray with resounding faith like you've never prayed before. There is an adage which says, there's a difference between someone who is seeking for a thing than someone who had found something he or she was seeking for. Therefore, pray with determination, pray as someone seeking divine restoration .

"So I will restore to you the years that the swarming [f]locust has eaten, The crawling locust, The consuming locust, And the chewing locust, My great army which I sent among you. 26 You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, And praise the name of the Lord your God, Who has dealt wondrously with you; And My people shall never be put to shame."

Joel 2: 25-26. May the glory of GOD descend upon your prayer altar as you seek Him today. Whatever Satan have stolen from you, for he is actively seeking whom to devour (I Peter 5: 8), such shall be restored to you today.
